Fortunately, if you live in DC, MD or No.VA there are options available for you: -Switch your Electricity provider to a renewable

source.

-Purchase offsets to your carbon production.

Before you make the leap to a greener 2021, please consider these important factors:

-shop carefully for 100% green-e certified wind energy credits,

-purchase a *fixed-rate* contract where they cannot raise the price.

-be vigilant about your contract end date (lest they *renew* you at a higher rate without your noticing).

District of Columbia

DC makes it relatively easy to Go Green: How to Sign up for Green Energy in DC if your Utility Company is Pepco.

Maryland

MD makes it a little more difficult but do able - find green-e certified suppliers for Maryland here.

Also, in MD most folks who pay an energy bill can <u>subscribe</u> to community solar projects through Neighborhood Sun.

Virginia

In No. Virginia Dominion Electric has programs which allow homeowners to purchase renewable energy offsets.

Many Green Team members who live in Virginia also switched to <u>Arcadia</u> Through Arcadia, you may power your home with renewable energy from a wind or solar farm.
