

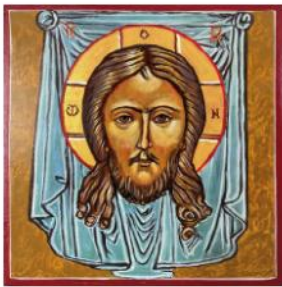

To my fellow Holy Trinity parishioners, I am delighted to have the opportunity to introduce myself to you as your new Director of Communications.

I am a Birmingham, AL, native, a recent D.C. transplant, and a lifelong Catholic who never could have imagined a parish as special as Holy Trinity existing before moving here just a year and a half ago. When I was first planning this big move back in March 2021, I knew that choosing a new parish home would be just as important as the choice of house and school—not least because the parish I chose would ultimately be where my daughter, Violetta, would be Confirmed the following year. (And she was, this past May!) We are blessed now to live in a wonderful home here in Georgetown, where our church is a one mile walk in one direction and Violetta's school is a one mile walk in the other direction. Never could I have predicted that our parish home would one day become my work home, too—and quickly, my work family.

It's funny how God "shows up" in our lives in the most unexpected ways. For nearly the past 10 years, ever since my daughter started Kindergarten, I have been fortunate to work entirely from home. My professional

background is rooted in the 24/7 work culture of advertising and marketing agencies with big clients, big, complex teams, and even bigger budgets, all moving at breakneck speed. So when, early on in my career, I experienced true and total burnout for the first time, I was ready to do something—*anything*—other than what I had been doing. I needed to do something for work that fed my soul for a change, however briefly. So I turned to one of the great loves of my life and I taught piano.

In classic me form (I never do anything halfway), I wound up continuing to teach piano for a few years—well beyond the few weeks or months I had originally expected and long after my professional return to agency life. Piano has always been a deeply spiritual and cathartic practice for me, like a form of therapy. So to have had the chance to teach and to grow and to help others to learn and to grow, is something that changed me in profound ways that I still find myself discovering all these years later. Most of all, it was this experience that provided my first glimpse of what meaningful professional work can be.

Holy Trinity is that rare gem—a place where so many find a community that is progressive, that is inclusive, that is loving, and that does real, tangible work to change the lives of our fellow human beings in myriad ways each and every day. These things are a constant here. It's what guided me to Holy Trinity as a parishioner, and it's what compelled me to accept the position of Director of Communications eight weeks ago. I am truly thrilled and honored to be a part of this incredible parish, to do meaningful work, and to serve you all in this role. I am also humbled to walk alongside each of you in some small way on our faith journeys. If you see me at Mass or at one in our seemingly endless lineup of events, please come say hello! I look forward to meeting you and to sharing this time together.

Mary's Magnificat and Hannah's Song SUNDAY, DECEMBER 11 – 10:15 AM, Trinity Hall

A special faith formation event sponsored by the Women Who Stay to celebrate the Women Who Sing! Tips from the HT Green Team

Wintertime Tips to Save Energy, Money, and Reduce Harmful Carbon Pollution

Use a programmable thermostat to reduce heat when you are away from home or asleep.

Seal and weatherstrip: you could improve the heating system efficiency by as much as 20%.

Keep your furnace air filters clean. At minimum, change the filter every three months.

Have HVAC equipment tuned-up annually.

Turn off kitchen, bath, and other exhaust fans within 20 minutes after use.

Close your fireplace damper when not in use.

Draperies and shades: Keep south-facing window shades open during the day and closed at night.

Select energy-efficient products when you buy new heating equipment. Look for Energy Star certification.

Make sure vents/registers aren't blocked or covered.

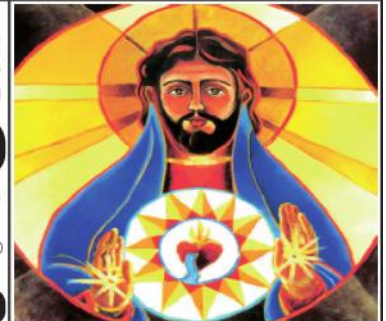


